## Using your NetID on iPad

## What is a NetID?

The University of Auckland provides a NetID as a login username to all people who have a formal association with the University. A NetID is usually based on the *first letter of your first name*, the *first three letters of your surname followed by three digits*, for example:

- kals782 might be allocated to a person called Ken Alsebrook
- bwu921 might be allocated to a person called Bernard Wu

If you are a new student, your NetID and password will have been in your "Acceptance of Application" email. You can change your password via The University of Auckland website at <a href="https://iam.auckland.ac.nz/password/change">https://iam.auckland.ac.nz/password/change</a>

Your NetID is used for many of the University of Auckland's electronic services such as *EC Mail* and *Student Services Online*, as well as logging into *iPad apps* such as Google Drive or Gmail.
