What is PeerWise?

PeerWise is a web-based application that is used to immerse students in lecture content by allowing them to generate, answer and discuss assessment questions created by their peers.

Your lecturer will create a PeerWise course that you can access online to begin creating and answering questions. Depending on your course assessment details, you may be required to complete a certain number of tasks on PeerWise, or you may simply use it as a tool to aid your study and communicate with other students.


Signing in to Peerwise

- 1 To begin using PeerWise, go to <http://peerwise.cs.auckland.ac.nz/>
- 2 Enter *The University of Auckland* into the school selection box, and press *Go*.
